The position provides Outreach and Prevention services to community parents to increase the awareness and knowledge of health education promotion for children ages 0 – 6 years of age.

**Typical Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Provides outreach and prevention services to community parents.
- Develops and plans HIPPY activities.
- Maintains a timely report management system.
- Maintains open and positive communication with families and department.
- Builds relationships, promotes program awareness and represents department within the Squamish Nation community.
- Participates as member of the Ayas Men Men Child & Family Services team.

**Education, Level of Experience & Hiring Requirements:**

- Certificate from a recognized college specializing in Childcare, Teacher’s Aide or Life Skills.
- Plus Five (5) to seven (7) years experience in child care role or as an early childhood educator working with children who have developmental delays or disabilities.
- As career progresses, incumbent may be required to successfully complete job-required, short-term upgrading, training and courses relating to classroom management, developmental delays and diagnoses in children, Squamish language, first nation’s child development, curriculum development, language immersion etc.
- Experience as a beginner user of Email, Internet, Excel, Word/WordPerfect.
- Previous experience working in a First Nations Community (particularly Squamish) is preferred.
- Must be able to provide a valid Criminal Records Check.
- Grade 12 plus eight (8) to ten (10) years may substitute for above education and experience.
