The Aboriginal Sport, Recreation and Physical Activity Partners Council (Partners Council) of BC is pleased to announce the **2011 BC Aboriginal Provincial Canoeing Championships** will be hosted by the **Seabird Island First Nation** from **July 23 to 24th, 2011 in Agassiz, BC.**

Aboriginal youth paddlers are invited to compete for the Aboriginal Provincial championship titles at this inaugural BC Aboriginal Provincial Championship event. This event is sanctioned by CanoeKayak BC. Please note this is NOT a Team BC Selection event. Registration is open to eligible participants - No pre-qualification required. Details below.

- Eligibility:** Participants must be a resident of BC and of Aboriginal ancestry (First Nations, Métis, Inuit).
- Age Categories and Divisions:** The canoeing championship consists of male and female singles, doubles and mix doubles for all age classifications. There will also be a 200m kayak event for all age classifications.
- (14U) born 1997 - 2001
 - (16U) born 1995 - 1996
 - (19U) born 1992 – 1994
- General:** NOTE: Canoes are *NOT* provided by the host. Competitors must supply their own traditional dugout canoe.
NOTE: Kayaks *WILL* be provided for the 200m kayak events.
- Registration Fee:** **\$12/participant.** Registration fee includes tournament entry, lunch (both days), water, insurance and other event costs.
- Accommodation Info:** Seabird Island community has areas available for camping at no charge. There are hotels and motels in the surrounding area of Seabird Island First Nation, including Harrison Hot Springs (15 minutes travel), Hope (18 minutes travel) and Chilliwack (25 minutes travel).
