# **RECAP: SPRING 2023 INFORMATION SESSIONS**




# **Engagement Questionnaire Results**






#### BASED ON WHAT YOU KNOW, DO YOU WANT TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE MEMBERSHIP CODE
