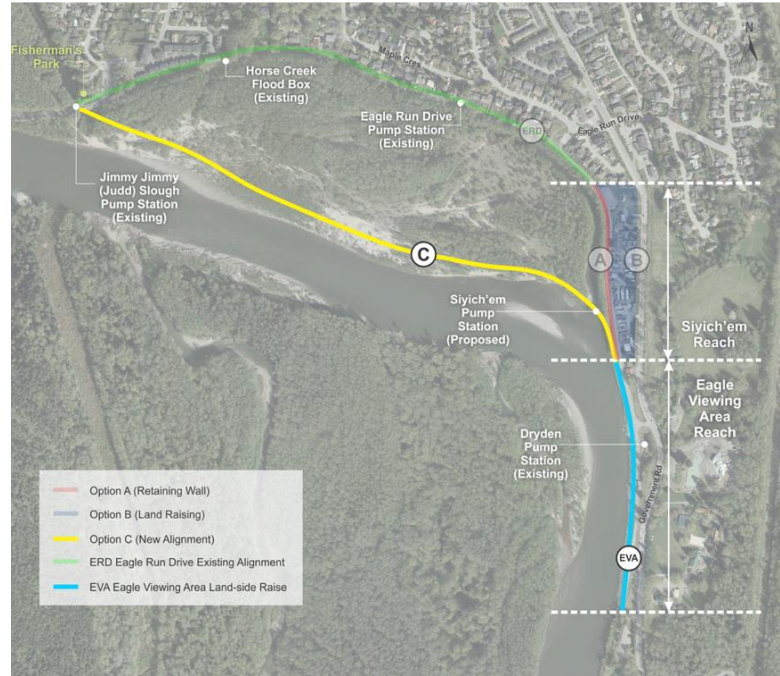


Project Context

Squamish Nation and the District of Squamish have partnered to develop a dike master plan for the Squamish River dike in the vicinity of the Siyich'em Reserve and along the Eagle Viewing Area.

Previous engagement on proposed options was conducted in November 2019. A preferred option has now been selected and endorsed by Squamish Nation Council and the District of Squamish Council. The selected option may enable the Squamish Nation to pursue recapture of unceded lands and historic reserve lands west of the existing dike. This proposed dike alignment is shown in the adjacent figure (Option C and EVA).



The dike master plan identifies a series of next steps to answer remaining questions and enable implementation towards future construction.
