JORDAN'S PRINCIPLE

Is your child eligible for Jordan's Principle?



- ◆ A child under the age of majority
- ◆ Is registered or eligible to be registered under the *Indian Act*;
- ◆ has one parent or guardian who is registered or eligible to be registered under the *Indian Act*;
- ◆ is recognized by Squamish Nation for purposes of Jordan's Principle; OR is ordinarily resident on reserve
