## NOTICE OF ELECTION - UPDATED 26 AUG 2021

Notice is hereby given that the **Squamish Nation** is holding an Election on **26<sup>th</sup> September, 2021** in accordance with the *Squamish Nation Election and Referendum Law and Regulation*, for the purpose of eligible voters electing four (4) members to the Office of General Councillor, and one (1) member to each of the Offices of North Shore Councillor, Regional Councillor, and Squamish Valley Councillor. The Office of Council Chairperson and position of Band Manager have been filled by Acclamation during the Nomination Process.

### VOTE ELECTRONICALLY - 26 AUG through 26 SEP 2021

Use the link below and follow the instructions provided to Register, and then Vote safely from anywhere on your phone or mobile device on voting day. You must provide your Band Registry Number (Status Card, starts with 555), date of birth, phone number, and an email address (only one member can vote per email address). Please contact the Electoral Officer immediately if you require any assistance whatsoever (see bottom of this Notice for contact information) - in particular, if you are entitled to vote for a different Local Area Councillor ballot than the one presented to you electronically. Please vote early in the day, to ensure assistance can be provided if required.

Voters will be able to vote on any one of the three Local Councillor ballots (North Shore, Regional, or Squamish Valley) at either of the above in-person poll stations: simply request the Local Councillor ballot of your choice at the poll station. All voters will also receive a second ballot to vote for the four (4) General Councillors.

### VOTE BY MAIL-IN BALLOT

Mail-in ballot packages will automatically be mailed to all electors who reside off-reserve in the North Shore and Regional, and Squamish Valley Voting Areas, for whom a current address has been provided to the Electoral Officer by the Squamish Nation administration. You will receive two ballots: one ballot for the four General Councillors, and one ballot for your appropriate Local Councillor (North Shore, Regional, or Squamish Valley). Please complete and return your mail-in ballots promptly, as those received after the close of polls on the 26<sup>th</sup> of September cannot be counted. If you receive one Local Councillor ballot ( North Shore, Regional, or Squamish Valley), but are entitled to a different Local Councillor ballot, contact the Electoral Officer by email or phone for a replacement ballot.

### ELECTED BY ACCLAMATION

The Office of Council Chairperson and the Position of Band Manager were filled by acclamation. There is no need to vote on these positions, so no ballots will be printed, mailed, or available for them.
