Ayas Men Men (AMM) provides the Squamish Nation Membership with delegated child & family services pursuant to the BC Child, Family and Community Act.

Family Care homes for AMM Children in care are recruited, studied, opened and supported by the AMM resource workers.

Care Givers Provide

Ayas Men Men Child and Family Services not only provides temporary homes, safety and nurturing to our children but also provides support to birth families by ensuring that children can be safely reunited with them.

When reunification is not possible, a plan is made to keep the children connected to the family and Squamish Nation, offering permanency and stability.



To become a caregiver: The Application Process

1. **Application Form**
2. **3 references**
3. **Medical Information Release Form**
4. **Criminal Record Check:** for every person over the age of 18 who lives in the home.
5. **Prior Records Check:** we will check to see if there has been any previous involvement with Ministry of Child and Family Development and the Ayas Men Men Program.
6. **Home Study:** after all the paperwork is complete, a resource worker will come to your home and do a series of interviews about your personal history, your parenting experience and your family values.
