The Child & Youth Support Division provides support services to families by having a safe, fun, holistic and cultural approach when working with our youth. We provide support to the children through working relationships with in the Squamish Nation and it's surrounding community. The emphasis is on cultural training, behavioral management and building self-esteem. The general practice and philosophy is to actively reach out to community youth to support the physical, emotional, nutritional and spiritual well-being of the youth, to encourage life skills development and provide cultural teachings.

Some of the programs are: Elhtach Family Camp, Young Achievers, Ayateway, Kwayestut, Camp Jubilee Cultural Camps, Boys and Girls Group, Hunters and Gatheres, Returning Home Canoe Journey, Canoe certification, and Food gathering.
