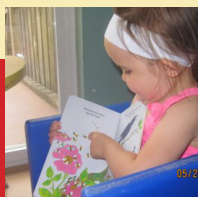


Home Instruction for Parents of Preschool Youngsters (HIPPY) Ages 3 - 5 years

The HIPPY program supports parents/ caregivers to be their child's first and most important teacher. HIPPY is about helping parents learn how easy, fun and rewarding it is to teach their children at home.

HIPPY is about:

- Spending 15 minutes a day with a storybook, puzzle or learning game
- Children entering kindergarten ready to succeed
- Helping parents feel good about their abilities
- Strengthening communities

- materials and books are provided
