The Youth & Prevention Services Team provides support services to families by having a safe, fun, holistic and cultural approach when working with our youth. We provide support to children & youth through working relationships with in the Squamish Nation and it's surrounding community. The emphasis is on cultural training, behavioral management and building self-esteem.

The general practice and philosophy is to actively reach out to community youth to support the physical, emotional, nutritional and spiritual well-being of the youth, to encourage life skills development and provide cultural teachings.



Some of the programs are: Elhtach Family Camp, Young Achievers, Ayateway, Kwayestut, Camp Jubilee Cultural Camps, Boys and Girls Group, Hunters and Gatherers, Returning Home Canoe Journey, Canoe certification, and Food gathering.

The Team ensures there is enough support in the community for families to survive crises without having to put children into care, and

for the entire family to lead healthy, productive lives. This involves leading an outreach team, developing educational programs as well as personally educating the community on awareness and warning

signs, as well as advising members of support systems available and where to turn in times of crisis.
