SQUAMISH NATION COMMUNITY NOTICE

Follow up to the Squamish Nation Community Meeting on February 27th - Protocol Agreement Update

On March 21st we circulated a joint community notice from the leadership of the Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh Nations. Together with Musqueam and Tsleil-Waututh, we are planning a **Protocol Agreement signing ceremony** on March 28th at the Musqueam Cultural Pavilion. On behalf of Chiefs & Council we extend an invitation to members that would like to attend this special signing ceremony which will take place at 10:00 am, followed by lunch. In addition to this notice and building on the foundation of the Protocol Agreement, Chiefs and Council are pleased to announce that the first steps in acquiring a significant property from the Province of British Columbia are complete. The property will be owned by an equal partnership between the three Nations and a development partner.

- The Liquor Distribution Branch Warehouse, located at 3200 East Broadway, Vancouver. A 9.21 acre parcel owned in partnership with the Musqueam and Tsleil-Waututh Nations, and a development partner.

The acquisition of this property is a significant step for our Nation. Under the direction and guidance of leadership this investment represents opportunities for generations to come.

We look forward to sharing more information on these developments in the days and months ahead.
