NOTICE OF WORK

Lions Gate Bridge, North Approach Viaduct
Repaving Test Section

With the completion of Phase One work on the North Viaduct of the Lions Gate Bridge, the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure will be undertaking Phase Two work to repave the Viaduct. Phase Two repaving will result in a smoother and safer ride for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians, and will significantly reduce noise for local residents.

To ensure Phase Two work is undertaken effectively and with minimum inconvenience, a repaving test section is planned for Sunday, June 14, beginning at 7AM and completed no later than 10AM. Located at the north end of the Viaduct, where the degradation of the existing asphalt is at its worst, the test area is approximately 20 metres in length and 2.5 metres wide. The work involves approximately 30 minutes of milling (removing the existing asphalt) followed by repaving the test area. Sunday morning traffic volumes are typically very light and will allow construction crews to access the test area with minimal affects to motorists.

With the test section complete, we will then prepare a construction work programme to mill and repave the entire length of the Viaduct. Myself and my project team will work closely with the community to ensure that residents are fully informed well in advance of the planned works.
