RE: **2014 FOOD FISH CATCH**

- SOCKEYE (limited to 5 per household)
- MIXED – (unlimited - pinks, springs, chum etc.)

The remainder of 2014 catch will be distributed Thursday, June 4, 2015 to those who want to top up household freezers or preserve for use. All fish has been flash frozen and maintained in commercial freezing units (from August 2014 – June 4, 2015). We do anticipate a low volume catch for 2015 and that occurs in August.
