



Dog Bylaw Enforcement on Reserve

Squamish Nation is committed to community health and safety and we intend to have a stronger bylaw enforcement presence as we move into the spring and summer months.

We will focus on educating band members of responsible dog ownership, but will seize and impound dogs found running at large, unlicensed dogs, and dogs that have inflicted an unprovoked bite on a person or another animal. Fines will be imposed on the owner and unpaid fines will be taken out of the distribution if necessary.

Other Bylaw Enforcement News:

The Nation will be incrementally building out a full bylaw enforcement function. We will be hiring a full-time bylaw officer to deal with matters such as unsightly yards, noise nuisance calls etc. Bylaw fines will be imposed and unpaid fines will result in garnishing distributions to pay off fines. More information will follow once we hire the fully trained and equipped bylaw officer.
