(Including those turning 18 on or before July 23, 2000).

> To **approve the settlement**:

- A majority must vote "yes".
- Both votes must pass:

As a Voter of the Squamish Indian Band do you:

approve the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement dated for reference the 11th day of May, 2000, having been given full opportunity to review the Settlement Agreement and acknowledging it to be in your best interest, and **authorize** the Council to sign all documents necessary to give effect to the Settlement Agreement on behalf of the Squamish Indian Band?

approve the terms and conditions set out in the Trust Agreement dated for reference the 11th day of May, 2000, having been given full opportunity to review the Trust Agreement and acknowledging it to be in your best interest, and **authorize** the Council to sign all documents necessary to give effect to the Trust Agreement on behalf of the Squamish Indian Band?

As a voter of the Squamish Indian Band, you are advised that under the Settlement Agreement Her Majesty in right of Canada will be relieved of any obligation or liability relating to the deposit, withdrawal, use, management or any other dealings by the trustees of the Compensation.

assent to absolutely surrender to Canada as set out in sections 38(1) and 39(1)(b)(iii) of the Indian Act all of the rights and interests, if any, of the Squamish Indian Band and its members in the Surrendered Lands as defined in the Settlement Agreement dated for reference the 11th day of May, 2000, having been given full opportunity to review the Settlement Agreement and the Absolute Surrender Document set out in Schedule "1" to the Settlement Agreement and acknowledging the same to be in your best interest, and **authorize** the Council to sign all documents necessary to give effect to the absolute surrender on behalf of the Squamish Indian Band?
