**Re: Housing Allocation (Phase 5), 15 lots**

*(Remaining 15 lots to be allocated in near future date)*

Please see below for Chiefs and Council's (C&C) key points in regards to the motion passed on January 26, 2018 of "15 Homes Allocation on Phase 5 Subdivision":

- On behalf of C&C and in collaboration and working with our Registry (Land & Registry) Department, we are pleased to announce that allocations have begun for Phase 5 in Capilano Reserve. 15 allocations were presented to C&C and we moved forward with the motion.
- Today C&C moved forward with the housing allocations for 2010/2011.
- In reference to the SN Housing Policy, page 2 under definitions; a list was provided to C&C determining to applicants eligibility, according to the housing list, membership category and date of application.
- This section (page 2, under definitions) was utilized to clarify eligibility for each of the 4 categories of the Housing Policy. This will continue to be so until the Housing Policy is potentially amended.
- Details of allocation for the 15 residents between the 4 categories was approved by C&C motion on October 9, 2002, and is as follows:
  - Pensioner – 3 allocations
  - Married Common Law – 8 allocations
  - Single Parent – 4 allocations
  - Single – 0 allocations
- We are looking forward to moving ahead with the remaining 15 lots, which are being prepared for allocation in the near future.

Thank you all for your continued understanding and respect to the Housing Allocation Process, we are excited to be moving forward with further allocations of homes for our dear membership.
