Deadline: April 17, 2025

Are you interested in submitting a People's Assembly Resolution?

This is your chance to help shape decisions for our community.

A resolution is:

- ✓ A way to propose changes, ideas, or actions on issues important to the Nation.
- ✓ A way to clearly share your priorities and concerns with Council.
- ✓ A formal statement that must be voted on at the People's Assembly.

Who can submit a resolution?

Any eligible Squamish voter (18+) who has an idea for change can submit a People's Assembly resolution. You don't need to have prior experience writing resolutions to submit - staff can assist you with developing your ideas.
