## FORTISBC EGP CONSTRUCTION UPDATES



FortisBC received approvals from District of Squamish and Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw to establish a temporary construction laydown yard northeast of Valleycliffe (Mamquam River FSR and Powerhouse Springs Rd) this Summer. The yard will be used to store equipment, materials, parking and fueling.

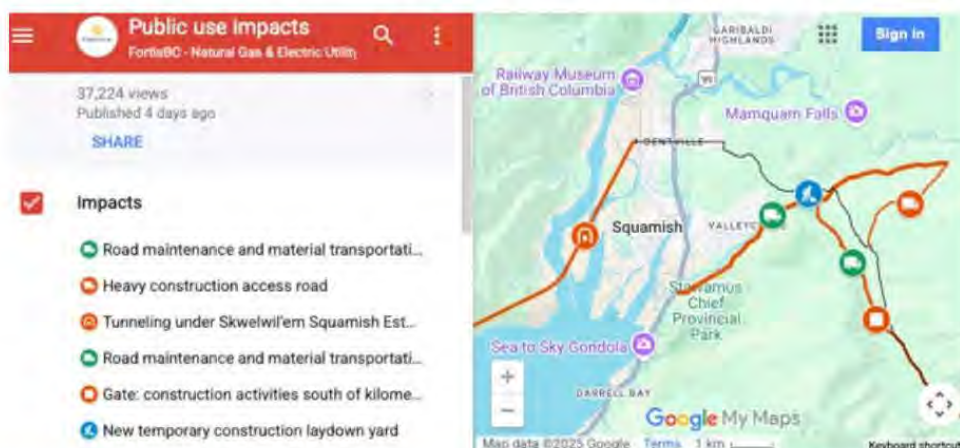
Grading and site preparation has been completed and yard activities will continue from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday to Friday, and from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturdays. Sound Barriers have been installed along the south side of the Valleycliffe laydown yard to mitigate noise impacts. While extensive in road works continue, traffic control personnel will continue to monitor the entry to the Stawamus FSR (up to KM 3) while large trucks travel along Forest Service Roads. Traffic control is also available to support with access to the Shannon Falls area off of the Stawamus FSR.

The Connector Trail, north of the construction laydown yard, was previously closed but has since opened.

Community members should contact swiyat@squamish.net or 778-966-1117 if they need to access the territory past the security gates as Rights and Title have ensured there is a process in place to enable Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw member continued access throughout the course of construction. Please provide us with one week notice whenever possible.
