### PROPOSED FLOATEL 2 UPDATE

**UPDATE FROM JUNE NEWSLETTER:** In order to maintain their project timeline, Woodfibre LNG plans to carry out some of their work simultaneously, thereby increasing the project workforce. As a result, Woodfibre LNG has applied to add a second Floatel to house up to 630 additional workers for the remainder of construction. Non-local workers would be ferried from Vancouver directly to the floatel avoiding local roads and community. Only local workers go to and from site via Darrel Bay.

At this stage, the application has been submitted to the Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw, the District of Squamish, EAO, and the Federal Impact Assessment Agency. Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw will conduct a thorough review of this application with consideration for all potential concerns, including environmental impacts to Howe Sound (e.g., herring and effects from shading) and social impacts.

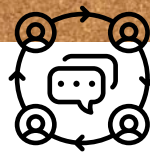

## FORTISBC EGP CONSTRUCTION UPDATES



We wanted to provide updates to the community members on traffic changes and have provided a summary of road works planned by FortisBC below:

### Upcoming Work Near CN Rail Tracks in Squamish

FortisBC is preparing to install a section of natural gas pipeline under the CN Railway tracks on private property in Squamish's Business Park using a trenchless method. Here are some key details:

- Work began the week of June 23 near Industrial Way and Queens Way.
- Hours: Monday–Friday, 7 a.m.–8 p.m.; Saturday, 8 a.m.–7 p.m.
- Expect increased noise as steel sheet piling is installed over 5 weeks.

This work is separate from the pipeline construction along Industrial Way and Finch Drive, expected to start in late 2025 or early 2026. FortisBC notified nearby businesses and residents and will continue to provide updates.

### Subsurface Investigation Along Finch Drive and Industrial Way

The week of June 23, FortisBC's crews started conducting additional subsurface investigations along Finch Drive and Industrial Way to inform upcoming pipeline construction, tentatively planned for late 2025 or early 2026. Here are some key details:

- Work hours: Monday–Friday, 7 a.m.–8 p.m.; Saturdays as needed, 8 a.m.–7 p.m.
- Some overnight work (7 p.m.–6 a.m.) expected on Industrial Way in July.
- Duration: 1 month.
- Single-lane alternating traffic on Finch Drive and Industrial Way.
- One night of single-lane closures on Highway 99.
- Signage and traffic control will be in place; access to homes and businesses will be maintained unless otherwise communicated.
