Saturday, November 15:

- Eligible Voters will vote on resolutions.
- Resolutions passed first at a People's Assembly and then at an Annual General Meeting become official recommendations to Council. After the AGM, Council and staff will review these resolutions for any risks, then present the results to the Squamish People.

Sunday, November 16:

- Eligible Voters will vote on resolutions.
- Staff will present the Squamish Nation Audited Financial Statements for 2024/25.
- Learn about the Nation's operations, finances, and see how well we met our goals.


Deadline to register: November 11, 2025
