Registration now open at Capilano Little Ones School

Registration for the 2026/2027 school year at Xwemélch'stn Etsimxwawtxw (Capilano Little Ones School) is underway and ongoing until June 30

Skwxwú7mesh families with eligible children can now sign up for K4 and K5 classes (kindergarten for children aged four and five), as well as for new students enrolling in Grades 1–7.

Current students who are returning do not need to re-register.

Children are given priority registration if they are:

- A registered Squamish Nation Member
- A child of a Registered Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw Member
- A registered Status Indian residing on a Squamish Nation Reserve

If a child does not meet the above criteria, they may be registered if the school has available space and other applicable eligibility requirements are met. For more information visit: <https://capilanolittleones.com>.

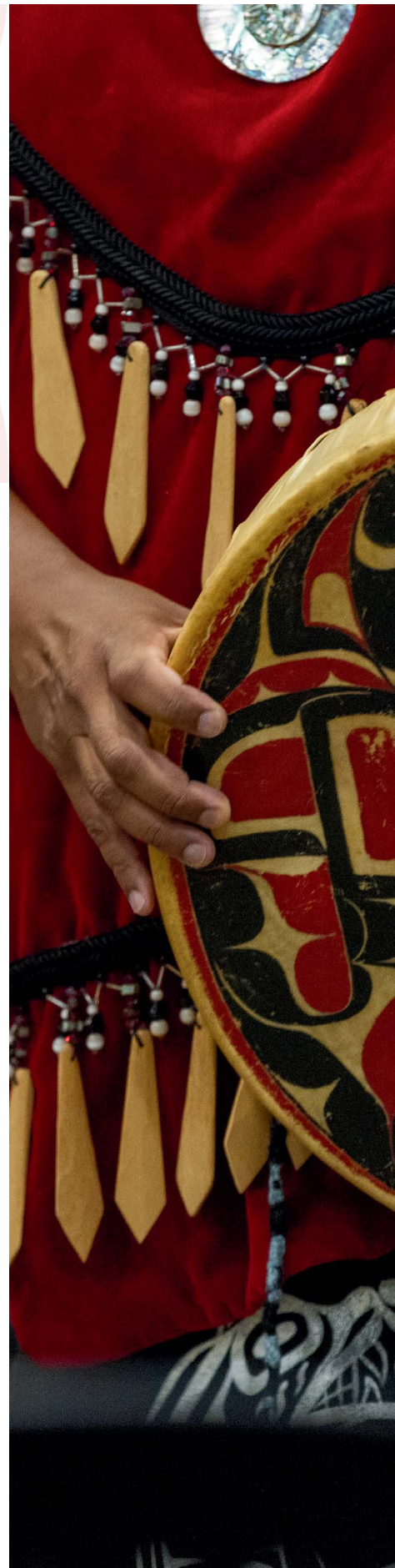

Sheykwáwtxw development investing in Skwxwú7mesh community

Hiyám' Housing is not just building homes they're strengthening the Skwxwú7mesh Nation's economy and supporting pathways to prosperity.

The Sheykwáwtxw (Clam House) development is a one hundred thirty-seven million dollar project that will include significant opportunities for Squamish participation through cultural expression, employment, contracting opportunities, and training.

Through an Indigenous Participation Plan (IPP), Hiyám' Housing's Sheykwáwtxw development project is expected to provide business and training opportunities to Squamish People. The IPP is a collaboration between Hiyám' Housing, Nch'kay, Squamish Nation's Sts'its'áp'newas (Employment & Future Skills) and Nexw7áystwaý (Training and Trades Centre), Ventana Construction, and Lu'ma Development.

“This partnership will create meaningful economic development opportunities for Squamish People's businesses, as well as employment opportunities that support skills development and provide benefits to community over the long-term,” said Sarah Silva, CEO of Hiyám' Housing.

Part of the procurement process for the Sheykwáwtxw development project is an upcoming Bidder's Meeting for all invited contractors, including Skwxwú7mesh Nation community businesses and contractors who have been endorsed through the Nch'ú7mut Endorsed Business Registry.

The Bidders Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 27, at the Lynn Creek Community Recreation Centre.

A Bidders Meeting provides an opportunity to learn and ask questions about the project, the tender process, and information bidders are required to provide as part of their bid submission in accordance with the project's IPP.

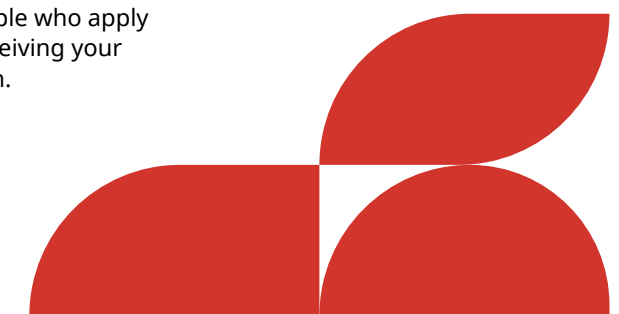
