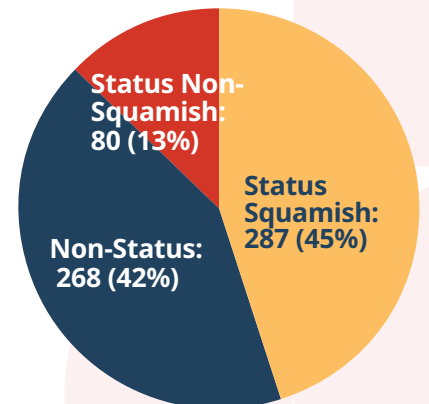

### Staffing Numbers Explained

**By the Numbers:** What do these numbers mean?

The total employee number reflects all the permanent and fixed-term employees (contracted staff working for a predetermined time, eg. one-year project) who currently work for Squamish Nation -- as of July 2, 2026. This number goes up and down based on new hires, movement within departments and promotions.

**Squamish Member Hires** reflects any new position accepted/taken by a Squamish Person — it includes any new signed employment agreement. This would include current Squamish employees who get a promotion or take a new position in a different department, or hires to backfill a position.
